### **DEBSWANA DECISION ON INFOTRAC LITIGATION JUDGEMENT**

Following the judgement delivered on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> June in the matter of Infotrac v Debswana, The company has reviewed and considered the Judgement of the High Court. Based on legal advice which Debswana has received, a decision has been taken to appeal the Judgement. In that regard, a Notice and Grounds of Appeal has been filed with both the High Court and Court of Appeal by Debswana. The Company stands by its position as set out in the evidence presented to the court and remains hopeful that the appeal process will vindicate this position.
